Burbank Public Library seeks experts to teach classes in the Spark! Digital Media Lab. This is a paid, contract opportunity. The Spark! Lab is a technology training space with equipment and software for audio and video production, 3D printing, animation, coding and more.

Instructors are sought with expertise in one or more of the following areas:

- Coding – Python, HTML, C# or C++
- Adobe Creative Suite – Illustrator, Photoshop, Lightroom, InDesign or others

Instructors are required to develop and deliver a single or series of classes for a 2-hour period each. Classes may have between 8 to 15 people depending on the available equipment and will be held onsite at Burbank Central Library. Instructors will be compensated \$600 per 2-hour class, inclusive of all expenses.
