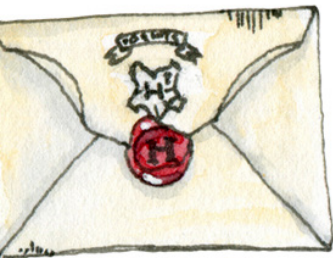

Alexander, Lloyd ~ *The Chronicles of Prydain* (Series)

A young pigkeeper has adventures far beyond his station: battling the Horned King, destroying the Black Cauldron and rescuing the Princess Eilonwy.



Almond, David ~ *Skellig*

Unhappy about his baby sister's illness and the chaos of moving into a dilapidated old house, Michael retreats to the garage and finds a mysterious stranger who is something like a bird and something like an angel. **AR 3.5**

Bath, K.P. ~ *The Secret of Castle Cant: Being an Account of Remarkable Adventures of Lucy Wickright, Maidservant and Spy*

When 12-toed orphan Lucy Wickwright is brought to Castle Cant to be a serving girl to the Baron's daughter, she becomes involved with revolutionaries and uncovers surprising palace intrigues. **AR 6.6**

Bellairs, John ~ *The Dark Secret of Weatherend* (Anthony Monday Series #2)

Fourteen-year-old Anthony Mundy and the town librarian try to prevent an evil wizard from turning the world into an icy wasteland. **Not AR**

Bellairs, John ~ *The House With a Clock in its Walls* (Lewis Barnavelt Series #1)

A boy goes to live with his magician uncle in a mansion with a clock hidden in the walls that is ticking off the minutes until doomsday. **AR 5.0**

Bellairs, John ~ *Trolley to Yesterday* (Johnny Dixon Series #6)

Johnny Dixon and Professor Childermass discover a trolley that transports them back to Constantinople in 1453 as the Turks are invading the Byzantine Empire. **AR 5.9**

Blackwood, Sage ~ *Jinx* (Series #1)

A young boy named Jinx encounters magic and danger as he grows up in the deep, dark forest known as the Urwald and discovers that the world beyond--and within--the Urwald is more complex than he could imagine. **AR 4.2**

Bosch, Pseudonymous ~ *Bad Magic* (The Bad Books Series #1)

Thirteen-year-old Clay, a boy who no longer believes in magic, tags graffiti on his classroom wall and, as punishment, is sent to a camp for wayward kids located on a volcanic island, where eccentric campmates abound, a ghost walks among the abandoned ruins of a mansion, and a dangerous force threatens to erupt with bad magic. **AR 5.2**

Boston, Lucy M. ~ **The Children of Green Knowe** (*Green Knowe Series #1*)

Tolly comes to live with his great-grandmother at the ancient house of Green Knowe and becomes friends with three children who lived there in the 17th century. **AR 5.3**

Colfer, Eoin ~ **Artemis Fowl** (*Series #1*)

When a 12-year-old evil genius tries to restore his family fortune by capturing a fairy and demanding a ransom in gold, fairies fight back with magic, technology, and a particularly nasty troll. **AR 5.0**

Collins, Suzanne ~ **Gregor the Overlander** (*The Underland Chronicles Series #1*)

An epic battle between men, bats, rats, cockroaches, and spiders is triggered when Gregor and his sister are pulled into a strange underground world while on a quest foretold by an ancient prophesy. **AR 4.8**



Cooper, Susan ~ **The Boggart** (*Series #1*)

After visiting the castle in Scotland that her family has inherited and returning home to Canada, 12-year-old Emily finds that she has accidentally brought back with her a boggart, an invisible and mischievous spirit with a fondness for practical jokes. **AR 6.1**

Cooper, Susan ~ **Over Sea, Under Stone** (*The Dark is Rising Series #1*)

Three children set out to find King Arthur's grail, touching off a struggle between the forces of good and evil, the Light and the Dark. **AR 5.4**

Coville, Bruce ~ **Dragon of Doom** (*Moongoble and Me Series #1*)

Life in the village of Pigbone is boring until an aspiring magician and his talking toad come to town and ask Edward to help them slay the Dragon of Doom. **AR 3.3**

Coville, Bruce ~ **Jeremy Thatcher, Dragon Hatcher** (*Magic Shop Series #2*)

Small for his age but artistically talented, 12-year-old Jeremy Thatcher unknowingly buys a dragon's egg. **AR 4.9**

Dahl, Roald ~ **Charlie and the Chocolate Factory**

Four nasty, repulsive children and one honest, loyal and starving boy win a tour of the world's most fantastic chocolate factory from the world's most eccentric chocolatier. **AR 4.8**

Dahl, Roald ~ **Matilda**

Brilliant first-grader Matilda triumphs over her book-hating parents and Miss Trunchbull, the odious school principal. **AR 5.0**

Dahl, Roald ~ **The Witches**

A boy and his grandmother thwart the plans of England's witches to turn all children into mice. **AR 4.7**

DiCamillo, Kate ~ **The Tale of Despereaux: Being the Story of a Mouse, a Princess, Some Soup, and a Spool of Thread** (*Newbery Award*)

These are the adventures of Despereaux Tilling, a small mouse of unusual talents, the princess that he loves, the servant girl who longs to be a princess, and a devious rat determined to bring them all to ruin. **AR 4.7**

DiTerlizzi, Tony ~ **The Field Guide** (*The Spiderwick Chronicles*)

After moving to a creepy old mansion, the Grace kids come to believe that an old book with hand-drawn pictures holds the key to all the weird things that have been going on. **AR 4.2**

Duane, Diane ~ **A Wizard Abroad** (*Young Wizards Series #4*)

Sent on vacation to her aunt's house in Ireland, teenage witch Nita becomes involved in a magic battle to save the country from the ghosts of its past. **AR 5.6**

DuPrau, Jeanne ~ **The City of Ember** (*Books of Ember Series #1*)

The city of Ember was built as a last refuge for the human race. Two hundred years later, the great lamps that light the city are beginning to flicker. When Lina finds part of an ancient message, she's sure it holds a secret that will save the city. She and her friend Doon must decipher the message before the lights go out on Ember forever! **AR 5.0**

Eager, Edward ~ **Half Magic** (*Tales of Magic Series #1*)

Jane, Mark, Katherine and Martha find a coin that grants half of every wish they make. **AR 5.0**



Funke, Cornelia ~ **Dragon Rider** (Series #1)

After learning that humans are headed toward his hidden home, Firedrake, a silver dragon, is joined by a brownie and an orphan boy in a quest to find the legendary valley known as the Rim of Heaven, encountering friendly and unfriendly creatures along the way, and struggling to evade the relentless pursuit of an old enemy. **AR 4.9**

Funke, Cornelia ~ **The Thief Lord**

Journey to the magical underworld of Venice for a tale of flight and freedom. **AR 4.8**

Ibbotson, Eva ~ **Not Just a Witch**

Determined to be more than just any ordinary witch, Heckie, whose specialty is changing people into animals, settles in a small town, determined to use her powers for good purposes. **AR 5.6**

Jacques, Brian ~ **Redwall** (Series #1)

When life at ancient Redwall Abbey is shattered by the evil rat Vluny, Matthias determines to find the legendary sword of Martin the Warrior, which will help Redwall's inhabitants destroy the enemy. **AR 5.6**

Juster, Norton ~ **Phantom Tollbooth**

Finding a car and a tollbooth in his bedroom, Milo drives off to rescue the lost princesses aided by the Spelling Bee and a watchdog named Tock. **AR 6.7**

Le Guin, Ursula K. ~ **A Wizard of Earthsea** (The Earthsea Cycle Series #1)

A boy grows to manhood while attempting to subdue the evil he unleashed on the world as an apprentice to the Master Wizard. **AR 6.7**

L'Engle, Madeleine ~ **A Wrinkle in Time** (Newbery Award, Time Quintet Series #1)

When an atomic physicist disappears on a secret mission, his son and daughter and their friend search for him, going on an interplanetary journey through time and space. **AR 4.7**

Levine, Gail ~ **Ella Enchanted**

In this unique version of the Cinderella story, Ella struggles against the childhood curse that forces her to obey any order given her. **AR 4.6**

Lewis, C.S. ~ **Chronicles of Narnia** (Series)

Four English school children enter the magic land of Narnia through the back of a wardrobe and assist Aslan, the golden lion, in defeating the White Witch who has cursed the land with eternal winter.

Nimmo, Jenny ~ **Midnight for Charlie Bone** (*Children of the Red King Series #1*)

Charlie Bone's life with his widowed mother and two grandmothers undergoes a dramatic change when he discovers he can hear people in photographs talking.

Paolini, Christopher ~ **Eragon** (*Inheritance Cycle Series #1*)

Fifteen-year-old Eragon believes that he is merely a poor farm boy until his destiny as a Dragon Rider is revealed. Gifted with only an ancient sword, a loyal dragon, and sage advice from an old storyteller, Eragon is soon swept into a dangerous tapestry of magic, glory, and power. **AR 5.6**

Pearce, Ridley ~ **The Kingdom Keepers** (*Series*)

Finn Whitman, an Orlando teen, is hired to be hologramed as a Disney World park "guide" but soon finds himself being transported into the Magic Kingdom in the dead of night to help fight a group of Disney villains, led by Maleficent, who want to take over Disney World--and maybe more.

Pullman, Philip ~ **The Golden Compass** (*His Dark Materials Series #1*)

Lyra tries to prevent her best friend and other kidnapped children from being the subject of experiments. **AR 7.1**



Riordan, Rick ~ **Magnus Chase** (*Series*)

Magnus Chase has always been a troubled kid. Since his mother's mysterious death, he's lived alone on the streets of Boston, surviving by his wits, keeping one step ahead of the police and the truant officers. One day, he's tracked down by an uncle he barely knows--a man his mother claimed was dangerous. Uncle Randolph tells him an impossible secret: Magnus is the son of a Norse god.

Sage, Annie ~ **Magyk** (*Series*)

After learning that she is the Princess, Jenna is whisked from her home and carried toward safety by the Extraordinary Wizard, those she always believed were her father and brother, and a young guard known only as Boy 412--pursued by agents of those who killed her mother ten years earlier.

Schlitz, Laura Amy ~ **Splendors and Glooms**

When Clara vanishes after the puppeteer Grisini and two orphaned assistants were at her twelfth birthday party, suspicion of kidnapping chases the trio away from London and soon the two orphans are caught in a trap set by Grisini's ancient rival, a witch with a deadly inheritance to shed before it is too late. **AR 5.1**

Stroud, Jonathan ~ **The Amulet of Samarkand** (*Bartimaeus Series #1*)

Nathaniel, a magician's apprentice, summons up the djinn Bartimaeus and instructs him to steal the Amulet of Samarkand from the powerful magician Simon Lovelace. **AR 5.9**

Tolkien, J.R.R. ~ **The Hobbit, or There and Back Again**

Bilbo Baggins, a respectable, well-to-do hobbit, lives comfortably in his hobbit-hole until the day the wandering wizard Gandalf chooses him to share in an adventure from which he may never return. **AR 6.6**

Valente, Catherynne M. ~ **The Girl Who Circumnavigated Fairyland in a Ship of Her Own Making** (*Fairyland Series #1*)

Twelve-year-old September's ordinary life in Omaha turns to adventure when a Green Wind takes her to Fairyland to retrieve a talisman the new and fickle Marquess wants from the enchanted woods. **AR 5.8**

Winthrop, Elizabeth ~ **The Castle in the Attic** (*Series #1*)

William is given a toy medieval castle as a gift, and is magically transported to another world of wizards and dragons. Here he must fight a battle between good and evil. **AR 4.9**

Wrede, Patricia ~ **Dealing With Dragons** (*Enchanted Forest Chronicles Series #1*)

Bored with traditional palace life, a princess goes off to live with a group of dragons and soon becomes involved with fighting against some disreputable wizards who want to steal away the dragons' kingdom. **AR 5.5**

Yolen, Jane ~ **Passager** (*The Young Merlin Trilogy #1*)

A founding rediscovers his identity through the help of the falconer who adopts him. **AR 5.1**

Yolen, Jane ~ **Wizard's Hall**

A young apprentice wizard saves the wizard's training hall by trusting and believing in himself. **AR 5.0**
